Key Findings 2023

Executive Summary

- Two main trends expansion of ranked individuals, specifically "next generation" and "Rising Stars" which consists of 52 percent of the new entries in the individual rankings. For the third straight year, more movement down than up.
- In 2023 there are the same amount of changes in the practice areas (73 moves), less than in comparison to 2021(105 moves), 2019 (175) and 2020 (134). Second time in recent history where we count more movements down than up (40 to 36).
- 108 lawyers entered the individual rankings (leading/next generation/rising stars) however, many have found themselves out 24 lawyers have been pushed out (amounts to the sum of the past 5 years combined).

Executive Summary


- Five law firms moved up to Tier-1.
- Practice with the most negative improvements IP:Disputes, IP:Patents, IP:Trademarks, White Collar and tax.
- Practice with the most improvements is dispute resolution, for the third straight year (4 moves up and 1 new entry).
- Practices with the most new lawyers to enter the rankings: Class Actions (12), Competiton (11) and Employment (8).

Executive Summary

Additional Stats (Among Israel's top-25 law firms):

- average number of moves up in the rankings, per firm -0.75 (as opposed to 0.6 in 2022 and 1.5 in 2021) and average of going down 0.5.
- average of new individuals in the rankings, per firm, is 2.6 (in comparison to 2.2 in 2022).
- only 25 law firms have climbed the rankings with 1 move or more (up and new). Out of that, 14 are top-20 firms, 2 mid-size and 9 niche firms.
- only 8 law firms have more than 5 new individuals in the rankings.


Improvements in 2023 (ranked practices)



Number of times a law firms is mentioned (by directory). Data: Legal BI




Total number of changes - overall

Total number of changes - individuals










Total number of changes per practice












Best Performing by Practices

- 17 additional law firms had one movement up or entered the rankings.


Best Performing by Individuals


